HAVING REGARD TO the Decree of the President of the Republic no. 445, dated 28.12.2000;

HAVING REGARD TO articles 2 and 12 of the Decree of the President of the Council of Ministers issued on 9 April 2001, "Uniformità di trattamento sul diritto agli studi universitari" [uniformity of treatment regarding the right to university education];

HAVING REGARD TO the Regulations for Administration, Finance and Accounting, issued with D.R. no. 828 prot. no. 7766 dated 14/03/2014 and, in particular, articles 75 and 79;

HAVING REGARD TO the agreement between the Renzo Piano Foundation and the Politecnico di Milano

HEREBY DECREES

the issue of the call for applications for 1 "**Renzo Piano Foundation**" scholarship for the 2017 year.

Art.1

The call is open to all Politecnico di Milano students duly enrolled for the 2016/2017 AY in the second year of a Laurea **Magistrale** (equivalent to a Master of Science) **or** the fifth year of a **single-cycle programme** at **the School of Architecture Urban Planning Construction Engineering** who, on the closing date of the call, have acquired in their career

- a weighted **average** of at least **27/30**:
- at **least 80 CFU** if enrolled in the second year of a Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to a Master of Science);
- at **least 200 CFU** if enrolled in 5th year of a single-cycle Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to a Master of Science).



The skills required are:

- detailed knowledge of the work of Renzo Piano and RPBW;
- good knowledge of the computer programs that are used by the firm, in particular: Autocad, Revit, Photoshop and Rhinoceros;
- good knowledge of English supported by any certifications.

The scholarship includes:

- disbursement of the amount of €8,500.00 before tax and inclusive of charges due by the Politecnico di Milano;
- an internship at the Renzo Piano Building Workshop in GENOA for a period of six months (from 26 February to 3 August 2018).

To benefit this scholarship, the winner has to be still a student (not graduated) of Politecnico di Milano until the end of the internship.

Art. 2

Applicants must submit their request for participation through the specific section in the Online Services http://www.polimi.it/onlineservices (Benefits and Agreements > Economic benefits) **no later than 12.00 noon (Italian time) on 04 September 2017.**

Attached to participation applications must be the documents listed below, in PDF format no bigger than 10 MB:

- Curriculum Vitae, accompanied by any certificates of proficiency in English;
- 2. **portfolio**, in A4 format, of the best works developed throughout the student's career;
- 3. **letter** of motivation (or statement of purpose).

The files must be named as Surname-Name-Type of document.pdf (for example Rossi-Mario-curriculum.pdf)

The application is complete with the submission of the request for participation in this call for applications and implies the acceptance of its rules and regulations.

Applicants are responsible for checking the procedure is properly completed.

Failure to complete the application or to submit it means applicants will be excluded from the selection process.

Art.3

A first assessment, carried out directly by the Rector or his representative, will be **based on the documents listed above** and will also take account of



the average and of the number of credits duly recorded in the career at the closing date of the call.

Only students deemed suitable will be called for the interview comprising the second part of the selection process which will take place by 13 September 2017.

The interview will be held by the Rector or his representative.

Selection for the interview will be communicated to each candidate by email sent to their institutional address.

If a candidate does not turn up on the day scheduled for the interview, he/she will automatically be excluded from the selection.

The selection results will be published **by 15 September 2017** on the University's official website.
