HAVING REGARD TO the letter prot.n. 36945 of 13/04/2018 , with which the representatives of the company Dalmine S.p.A., Paolo Benzi and Maurizio Sclavi, have expressed the intention of donating to the Politecnico di Milano the amount of € 45.570,00 to promote study activities in the field of engineering, through the award of 15 scholarships in the name of "Roberto Rocca" to students enrolled in the academic year 2017/2018 in the first and second year of the Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to Master of Science) in the of Engineering programs of the Politecnico di Milano;

HAVING REGARD TO D.Dir. No. 2692, prot. No. 36565, dated 20/04/2018 stating the acceptance of the donation decided by the company Dalmine S.p.A.;

HEREBY DECREES

The issue of the call for applications **for 15 "Roberto Rocca"** scholarships for the academic year 2017/2018.

Recipients and features of the scholarships

The competition is open to students who in the academic year 2017/2018 are enrolled in the Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to Master of Science) in the Schools of Engineering of the Politecnico di Milano, by the closing date of this call for applications.

Admission requirements

The n. 15 scholarships, for a total value of € 42.000,00 net of the taxes paid by the university, are divided as follows:

8 scholarships, for € 2.800,00 gross each, net of the taxes paid by the Politecnico di Milano, reserved to students **enrolled in the academic year 2017/2018** in Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to Master of Science) programmes in:

- Automation and Control Engineering - Ingegneria dell'Automazione
- Chemical Engineering - Ingegneria Chimica
- Computer Science and Engineering – Ingegneria Informatica
- Electrical Engineering - Ingegneria Elettrica
- Electronics Engineering - Ingegneria Elettronica

1. Curriculum Vitae et Studiorum

The files must be named as Surname-Name-Type of document.pdf (for example Rossi-Mario-CV.pdf)

The application is complete with the submission of the request for participation in this call for applications and implies the acceptance of its rules and regulations.
Applicants are responsible for checking the procedure is properly completed.

After closure of the Notice a receipt can be printed and the application cannot be changed any more. Applicants will be allowed to delete the request and submit it again (ex novo) before the deadline.

Failure to complete the application or to submit it means applicants will be excluded from the selection process.

art. 4 **Granting of scholarship**

The students admitted to the competition for meeting the requirements specified in Art. 1 and 2 shall take an on-line test of logic and verbal skills in September.

A ranking list will be drawn up based on the outcome of the test and the evaluation of the curriculum vitae et studiorum.

The first 12 candidates of each category will be invited to participate in an assessment meeting of the skills and transversal skills possessed.

The schedule of the meetings, organised by the Judging Panel at the Dalmine offices (BG), p.za Caduti 6 July 1944, No.1, will be disclosed after the publication of the list of applicants who passed the first selection phase.
The meetings will be held in Italian in September.

On the basis of the outcome of the test on line, of the curriculum and of the interview, the final ranking will be drawn up by a Judging Panel designated after the expiration date of the call by a Decree of the Manager.

The Judging Panel considers that none or a part of the candidates is to be considered eligible, all or part of the scholarships will not be assigned.

The winners are invited to participate in the award ceremony in October at the company's headquarters in Dalmine.

art. 5 **General rules**

Combination of economic aid: This scholarship may not be combined with other forms of financial assistance awarded by the Politecnico, in particular with Diritto allo Studio benefits, for the relevant academic year of this Call. The scholarship can however be combined with contributions for international mobility provided by Politecnico or other public or private entity. The scholarship can also be combined with exemptions from university fees and contributions.

Revocation: the scholarship can be revoked if the recipient is subject to disciplinary sanctions. It is still subject to revocation in case of waiver the studies and transfer to another university, current year.

Award: the scholarship money will be paid in one instalment. Winners will be informed of the scholarship award via an e-mail sent to their university e-mail address after the publication of the student ranking list. No later than 10 days from receiving the e-mail, the winners must sign and send the specific forms they will find attached to the award notification.

Waiver: if the winner waives the scholarship, it will be assigned to the next applicant in the ranking.

Taxation: the awarded scholarships are subject to the current laws governing the taxation of scholarships. The sum paid as the scholarship is to be treated as income comparable to income from employment for taxation purposes. The tax due by the Politecnico di Milano is IRAP (equal to 8.5% of the value of the scholarship).

Self-certification of data: if controls by the Politecnico di Milano establish that the information supplied was false, all benefits obtained will be withdrawn.

art. 6 **Processing of personal data**

Pursuant to Legislative Decree 196 dated 30.06.2003, the l'Area Sviluppo e Rapporti con le Imprese (the Data Controller of the supplied personal data), guarantees that the data will be used only to fulfil the obligations related to this procedure.

Personal data supplied to Dalmine S.p.A. with specific authorisation under Legislative Decree 196/2003, including sensitive data, may be used by the company for staff search and selection purposes.
