art. 1

Introduction

Giulia Minola, a passionate student of the School of Design enrolled in the Fashion Design Laurea (equivalent to Bachelor of Science), died prematurely, together with 20 young people from all over the world, on 24 July 2010 during the tragic LoveParade musical event in Duisburg, Germany.

With her family’s donation, we established a degree award in her memory.

art. 2

Description of the degree award and recipients

The degree award of **€ 1,000** is net of all taxes and fees borne by Politecnico di Milano. It will be awarded for the best degree thesis of those addressing topics connected with: *“Clothing”*

Students who have obtained the following Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to Master of Science) from Politecnico di Milano are eligible to participate:

- Design for the Fashion System

- from 1 July 2019 to 31 December 2020
- with a graduation score of not less than 105/110

The Research, Innovation and Corporate Relations Division shall check that applicants possess the necessary requirements.

art. 3 **How to participate?**

Applicants must submit their application through the appropriate function available in the Online Services: <http://www.polimi.it/servizionline> (Agevolazioni e Convenzioni > Borse di studio, premi di laurea, esoneri e bandi generici [Benefits and Agreements > Scholarships, degree awards, exemptions and general calls for applications]) **by 12 pm (Italian time) on 10 February 2021.**

Under the relevant procedure, applicants **must attach** the following:

- **their degree thesis in pdf format, with a maximum size of 15 MB**

The file must be named according to the following format: Surname-Name-Type of document.pdf (for example, Bloggs-Joe-Thesis.pdf)

Completion of the online application is equivalent to submitting an application for participation in this call for applications, and implies acceptance of its contents. It is the applicant's responsibility to check that they have properly completed the procedure.

After having completed and submitted the application, the applicant may print a receipt and the application may no longer be edited. The applicant can delete the application and submit a fresh one before the deadline set out in this call.

Failure to complete and submit the application, or submitting an incomplete application will result in the applicant being excluded from the assessment.

Each co-author for a thesis with multiple participants who intends to compete for the award must present their application for participation individually.

art. 4 **Selection Committee**

The granting of the degree award is decided based on a ranking drawn up by a Selection Committee appointed by managerial decree following the deadline of the call for applications.

The Committee will decide the ranking based on the attached thesis.

Provided that the requirements set out in art. 1 of the call for applications are met, the Committee may share the award among several applicants if there is an ex-aequo.

The Selection Committee may not award the prize if none of the applicants are deemed suitable.

The winner may be invited to a meeting with the donor family.

art. 5 **General rules**

Cumulability: the degree award is not cumutable with other prizes received for the same degree thesis.

Payment: the winner will be informed that they have been assigned the degree award via their university email address. Within 10 days of receipt of this communication, the winner must return the relevant forms attached to the award notification, signed for acceptance.

The award will be paid in a single payment by Politecnico di Milano.

Withdrawal: in the event of the winner withdrawing or failing to return the necessary forms by the established deadline, the prize will be awarded to the next highest applicant in the ranking.

Taxation: the amounts paid are subject to tax, under applicable scholarship legislation. The amount paid as a degree award is income considered similar to income from employment, and as such is subject to the same taxation. The taxes paid by Politecnico di Milano correspond to the IRAP rate of 8.5% of the total degree award.

art. 6 **Manager responsible for the selection process**

Under Art. 5 of Law 241 of 7 August 1990, the Manager for this call for applications process is Dr. Ivano Ciceri.

PRIVACY POLICY UNDER ARTICLE 13 OF THE EUROPEAN GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION (GDPR)

Politecnico di Milano (hereafter **Politecnico**), in its role of Data Controller, with registered office in Piazza Leonardo da Vinci 32, 20133 Milan – General Management office - informs you about the methods for processing your personal data, in compliance with EU Regulation 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 for the protection of personal data and related implementation regulations (hereafter the **Regulations**).

The Data Processor for the provided data is the Director of the Research, Innovation and Corporate Relations Division.

A. PERSONAL DATA COLLECTED

Your personal data collected and processed by Politecnico includes **(a)** the data communicated by you at the time of registration or enrolment, such as name, surname, date and place of birth, gender, tax code, nationality, residential address, telephone number, email address, educational qualifications; **(b)** the data collected upon submission of your application, particularly information on your academic career, the educational qualification obtained, and the information contained in your degree thesis.

B. PROCESSING PURPOSES AND METHODS

Your personal data may be processed for the following purposes:

1. for the public interest of verifying requirements for participation in the competition according to the criteria set forth in this call for applications and all other legal purposes, including statistical

For the above purposes, data processing by Politecnico shall be carried out using manual, electronic and remote means, limited to what is necessary for the purposes for which the data is processed, guaranteeing maximum security and confidentiality and in compliance with applicable legislation.

C. MANDATORY OR OPTIONAL DATA PROVISION

The provision of data for the purposes set forth in paragraph B point 1 is mandatory, and refusing to provide it will result in inadmissibility of the student's application and immediate exclusion from the process.

D. DATA COMMUNICATION AND CIRCULATION

Your personal data will be communicated to Politecnico employees who are authorised to process data. These are natural or legal persons who work for the Politecnico to implement the procedures for the selection and awarding of the benefit being competed for under this call for applications.

limit the processing of your personal data under art. 18 of the Regulations (*right to limit processing*);

oppose your personal data processing in the cases and under the methods set forth in art. 21 of the Regulations (*right to oppose*)
