**HAVING REGARD** to Managerial Decree no. 2348 ref. no. 43951 of 16/03/2021 which declares to accept the donation provided by Prof. Elisa Guagenti;

## **DECREES**

The call for applications **for 2 PhD thesis awards entitled “Prof. Giuseppe Grandori” year 2021.**

### **Art. 1**

#### **Introduction**

Professor Giuseppe Grandori (1921-2011) was an Emeritus Professor of Politecnico di Milano, Founder of Seismic Engineering in Italy, President of the International Association Earthquake Engineering (IAEE).

To celebrate his memory, in the centenary of his birth, Politecnico di Milano, with the collaboration of the Civil and Environmental Engineering Department (DICA), is establishing two PhD thesis awards, thanks to the donation of Prof. Elisa Guagenti Grandori.

### **Art. 2**

#### **Description of awards and recipients**

The 2 awards, each of the value of **€5,000.00** gross and net of costs borne by Politecnico di Milano, will be granted to the best PhD thesis from those addressing issues relating to “*Seismic Engineering*”.

Students who have achieved the PhD at an Italian university in the period from 1 January 2020 to 31 October 2021 may participate.

### **Art. 3** **How to participate**

Applicants must submit the application, subject to registering on the Politecnico di Milano Single Database, by way of the specific function available from Online Services <http://www.polimi.it/servizionline> (Agevolazioni e Convenzioni > Borse di studio, premi di laurea, esoneri, bandi generici [Subsidies and Conventions > Scholarships, degree awards, exonerations, generic notices]) **by 12pm (Italian time) on 04 November 2021.**

Applicants **must attach**, by way of the specific procedure, **each**:

- the PhD thesis in pdf format of a maximum 15 MB
- curriculum vitae
- reference letters (maximum two)
- self-certification of the PhD qualification
- copy of the identity document

The file must be named with Surname-First Name-Document Type.pdf (for example, Rossi-Carlo-Thesis.pdf)

The completion of the online application is equivalent to submitting an application for participation in this call for applications, and implies acceptance of its contents.

It is the applicant's responsibility to check that the procedure has been completed correctly.

After having completed and submitted the application, the applicant may print a receipt and the application may no longer be altered. The applicant may delete the application and submit a fresh one before the deadline set out in this call.

Failure to complete and submit the application, submitting an incomplete application or submitting inadequate documents will result in the applicant being excluded from the assessment procedure.

**For theses with several authors, each co-author intending to compete for the award must present individually their application for participation.**

### **Art. 4** **Selection Committee**

The granting of the degree award is decided based on a ranking drawn up by a Selection Committee appointed by managerial decree following the deadline of the call for applications.

In formulating the ranking, the Committee will decide on the basis of the assessment of the attachments uploaded by way of the specific procedure.

The fact of having developed issues strictly linked to seismic engineering and its application aimed at quantifying and mitigating the seismic risk will constitute a preferential aspect.

Provided that the requirements set out in Art. 2 of the call are met, in the case of ex-aequo, the Committee may share the award between several applicants. The Selection Committee may not give the awards if none of the applicants are deemed suitable.

The winners may be invited to a meet-and-greet with the donor.

#### **Art. 5** **General rules**

**Withdrawal/refusal:** should the winner withdraw their application or refuse the award, the award will be given to the applicant immediately following them in the ranking.

**Payment:** the assignment of the award will be communicated to the winner at the email address indicated when applying. Within 10 days of receiving that communication, the winner must return the relevant forms attached to the award notification, signed for acceptance.

The award will be paid in a single payment from the Politecnico di Milano.

**Tax status:** the payments awarded are subject to taxation, under the legislation in force regarding study awards. The amount paid as a degree award is income considered similar to income from employment, and as such is subject to the same taxation. The taxes paid by Politecnico di Milano correspond to the IRAP rate of 8.5% of the total degree award.

**Self-certification of data:** any ascertainment by Politecnico di Milano of false declarations leads to the forfeiture of any benefits received.

#### **Art. 6** **Head of the Procedure**

In accordance with the provisions of Art. 5 of Law, 7 August 1990, no. 241, the Head of this call for applications procedure is Dr Ivano Ciceri.

## **PRIVACY POLICY IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 13 OF THE EUROPEAN GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION (GDPR)**

The Politecnico di Milano (henceforth also **Politecnico**), in the role of the Data Controller, with offices at Piazza Leonardo da Vinci 32, 20133 Milan – General Management -, hereby informs you about the methods for processing your personal data, in compliance with EU Regulation 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of personal data and related implementing regulations (henceforth the **Regulation**).

### **PERSONAL DATA COLLECTED**

The personal data relating to you which is collected and processed by the Politecnico are **(a)** data provided by you upon registration or enrolment, such as name, surname, date and place of birth, sex, tax code, nationality, residential address, telephone and email contact details, educational qualifications; **(b)** data collected upon submission of your application, in particular, data related to your academic career, the qualification achieved, and the data contained in your PhD thesis.

### **A. DATA PROCESSING PURPOSES AND METHODS**

Your personal data may be processed for the following purposes:

1. for the public interest of verifying requirements for participation in the competition according to the criteria set forth in this call for applications and all other legal purposes, including statistical.

In relation to the aforesaid purposes, the data will be processed by Politecnico di Milano using manual, computerised and electronic tools, in a manner pertinent and limited to what is necessary with respect to the purposes for which the data are processed, and in any case in such a way as to guarantee the utmost security and confidentiality and always in full compliance with current legislation.

### **B. MANDATORY OR VOLUNTARY NATURE OF THE DATA PROVISION**

You have the right to:

to rectify any of your personal data that are erroneous pursuant to Art. 16 of the Regulation (so-called *right to rectification*)

to restrict the processing of your personal data pursuant to

Art. 18 of the Regulation (so-called *right to restriction of processing*);

to object to the processing of your personal data in the cases and by the methods set forth in Art. 21 of the Regulation (so-called *right to object*)
