**HAVING REGARD TO** Presidential Decree no. 445 of 28.12.2000;

**HAVING REGARD TO** articles 2 and 12 of the Decree of the President of the Council of Ministers issued on 9 April 2001 “Uniformity of treatment regarding the right to university education”;

**HAVING REGARD TO** the Regulations for Administration, Finance and Accounting, issued with D.R. no. 828 prot. no. 7766 dated 14/03/2014 and, in particular, articles 75 and 79;

**HAVING REGARD TO** the letter with prot. no. 129563 of 02/08/2021 in which Ms. Carola Rossana Croci, representative and Director HR and Organization of the company Artsana S.p.A, expresses his intention of donating to the Politecnico di Milano the sum of € 12,000.00 in order to pay for two scholarships under the name “#mammaE, in memoria del Cav. del Lav. Pietro Catelli, Fondatore di Artsana Group”, for female students who enrolled in the 2020/2021 academic year for the first year in the master's degree programme of Politecnico di Milano;

**HAVING REGARD TO** D.Dir. no. 6979/2021 Prot n. 131519 of 05/08/2021, declaring acceptance of the donation offered by the company Artsana S.p.A.;

### **HEREBY DECREES**

The announcement of a competition for **2 scholarships “#mammaE, in memoria del Cav. del Lav. Pietro Catelli, Fondatore di Artsana Group” a.a. 2021/2022.**

#### **art. 1**

#### **Features and recipients of the scholarship**

**Two** scholarships with a gross value of € 6,000.00 each, including expenses borne by the Politecnico di Milano, will be allocated to female students duly registered for 2021/2022 academic year in the Master’s Degree programmes of Politecnico di Milano.

#### **art. 2**

#### **Requirements for participation**

The competition is open to female students of Politecnico di Milano that meet the following conditions, at the time of the deadline of this call:

1. enrolment in the 2020/2021 a.y. in one of the following Master's Degree programmes:

Biomedical Engineering-Ingegneria Biomedica  
Chemical Engineering-Ingegneria Chimica  
Electronics Engineering -Ingegneria Elettronica  
Management Engineering-Ingegneria Gestionale  
Mechanical Engineering-Ingegneria Meccanica  
Design della comunicazione  
Integrated Product Design  
Product Service System Design – Design del Sistema Prodotto Servizio

2. registration in the 2021/2022 a.y. in the programme of the point 1

3. **at least 50 CFU** regularly registered and useful for graduation in his career

4. **weighted average** of the passed exams registered not less than **27/30 obtained by attributing an additional score of 3 points out of 30 for each awarding of honours.**

The Research, Innovation and Corporate Relations Division will ascertain the candidates' possession of the requirements listed above in the database of Politecnico di Milano.

## **art. 2** **Participation**

Applicants must submit their request for participation through the specific section in the Online Services <http://www.polimi.it/onlineservices> (Benefits and agreements> Economic benefits) **no later than 12.00 noon (Italian time) on 6 October 2021.**

The application is complete with the submission of the request for participation in this call for applications and implies the acceptance of its rules and regulations.

Applicants are responsible for checking the procedure is properly completed. Once the application has been completed and submitted it may no longer be changed and a receipt can be printed. Applicants will be allowed to delete the request and submit it again (ex novo) before the deadline.

Failure to complete and submit the application, submitting an incomplete application or submitting inadequate documents will result in the applicant being excluded from the assessment procedure.

## **art. 3** **Awarding of scholarships**

The assignment of the scholarships is decided based upon a ranking drawn up by the Research, Innovation and Corporate Relations Division.

The ranking will be formulated based upon the score determined by the formula:

The economic condition score is determined as follows:

from €23,121 to €27,000	100
from €27,001 to €31,000	90
from €31,001 to €40,000	80
from €40,001 to €51,000	70
from €51,001 to €63,000	70

from €95,001 to higher amounts	25

To that end, the **valid and compliant 2021 ISEE** (equivalent **ISEEU** for those not earning income in Italy), found in the University's **database by the call deadline** will be considered.

**In the absence of a valid and compliant 2021 ISEE/ISEEU** the student will be **attributed**, solely for the purposes of this ranking, the **highest ISEE/ISEEU (€95,001)**.

If candidates are still equal, the younger candidate will prevail.

All the scholarships of this competition or part of them could not be assigned, in the event that all or part of the candidates will not be considered eligible.

**art. 4**  
**General rules**

**Cumulability** –This scholarship may not be combined with other scholarships or forms of financial assistance awarded by the Politecnico, for the relevant academic year of this Call. **The scholarship can however be combined with Diritto allo Studio scholarship and benefits**, contributions for international mobility provided by

Politecnico or other public or private entity. The scholarship can also be combined with exemptions from university fees and contributions.

**Award:** the scholarship money will be paid in one instalment. Winners will be informed of the scholarship award via an e-mail sent to their university e-mail address after the publication of the student ranking list. No later than 10 days from receiving the e-mail, the winners must sign for acceptance and send the specific forms they will find attached to the award e-mail.

If the scholarship is not paid the remaining funds will be used to establish a new call.

**Renunciation:** in case the winner renounces or if the forms are not provided within the deadline, the allocation is awarded to the first suitable candidate that follows in the ranking list.

**Revocation:** the scholarship can be revoked if the recipient is subject to disciplinary sanctions. It is still subject to revocation in case of waiver the studies and transfer to another university, current year.

**Taxation:** the prize awarded is subject to the current laws governing the taxation of scholarships. For taxation purposes, the sum paid for the scholarship is to be treated as income comparable to income from employment. The tax due by the Politecnico di Milano is IRAP (equal to 8.5% of the value of the scholarship).

## **INFORMATION PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 13 OF THE EUROPEAN GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION**

Through this document, the Politecnico di Milano (hereinafter also called *Polytechnic*), as Data Controller, with offices located in Piazza Leonardo da Vinci 32, 20133 Milan - General Management -, informs you with regard to the processing of your personal data, in compliance to Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and Council dated 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals regarding the processing of personal data and related implementing legislation (hereinafter also called the *Regulations*).

The Data Processor, of the data provided by you, is the Director of the Research, Innovation and Corporate Relations Division.

### **A. PERSONAL DATA COLLECTED**

The personal data collected and processed by the Polytechnic, which regards you, is the following: (a) the data you communicated at the time of registration or enrollment, such as name, surname, date and place of birth, sex, social security number, nationality, address of residence, telephone and IT addresses, qualifications; (b) the data collected at the time of submission of the application, in particular the data relating to your academic career, CFU number and average.

### **B. PURPOSE AND METHOD OF PROCESSING**

Your personal data may be processed:

1. to verify eligibility requirements to participate in the competition according to the criteria set out in this announcement and for any other purpose required by law, also with the aim of processing statistical information

In relation to the aforementioned purposes, data processing by the Politecnico di Milano will take place using manual, computerized and electronic tools in a relevant manner and limited to what is necessary with respect to the purposes for which they are processed and, in any case, in order to guarantee the maximum security and confidentiality and, always, in full compliance with the legislation in force. The Politecnico will take all measures to promptly correct inaccurate data in relation to the processing purposes.

With reference to the particular data, the processing will be carried out in a proportionate manner with regard to the aim pursued, while adopting appropriate and specific measures to protect your fundamental rights.

### **C. COMPULSORY AND NON-COMPULSORY DATA**

Providing data, for the purposes referred to in paragraph B. point 1, is mandatory and any refusal to provide such data involves the inadmissibility of the application submitted by the student and the immediate exclusion from the procedure. Providing data for the

#### **D. DATA CIRCULATION AND COMMUNICATION**

Your personal data will be passed on to the Polytechnic employees who will be authorized to process this data, or to natural or legal persons who provide consulting services or collaborate with the Polytechnic for the purpose of providing the selection procedures as foreseen by the competition announcement. **Your personal data, also, will be sent to Artsana S.p.A. company to inform it about the result of the call.**

#### **E. RETENTION AND POSSIBLE TRANSFER OF PERSONAL DATA**

Your personal data will be stored at the Politecnico di Milano. Your data will not be transferred to a third country.

#### **F. PERSONAL DATA PERIOD OF RETENTION**

Your personal data will be kept for the time strictly necessary to guarantee access to the right to study benefits, unless the retention of data for a longer period is necessary for archiving purposes in the public interest, for scientific or historical research or for statistical purposes. Should data retention be needed for longer periods, the Polytechnic guarantees compliance with the principle of data minimization pursuant to art. 89, paragraph 1 of the Regulations.

#### **G. YOUR RIGHTS**

We would like to remind you that you have the right:

- to obtain information in relation to the ways in which your data is processed and any other information required by art. 15 of the Regulations (*right of access*)
- to obtain the correction of inaccurate personal data concerning you pursuant to art. 16 of the Regulations (*rectification right*)
- to obtain a limitation on the processing of personal data concerning you pursuant to art. 18 of the Regulations (*processing restriction right*);
- to oppose the processing of your personal data in the cases and under the conditions provided for by art. 21 of the Regulations (*right of opposition*)
