HAVING REGARD to last will and testament of Vittorio Noseda where he declares the intention to donate to the Politecnico di Milano the sum of € 400.000,00 in order to provide a scholarship in memory of prof. Giorgio Noseda for one or more graduating or graduated students in "Hydraulic Engineering";

HAVING REGARD to D.Dir. no. 3517 prot. no. 55397 issued on 21/06/2017, in which the donation is formally accepted;

HAVING REGARD to the availability of residual resources;

HEREBY DECREES

The issuance of competition notice for n. 2 scholarships "prof. Giorgio Noseda "a.y. 2021/2022.

art. 1 Recipients and scholarship features

The n. 2 scholarships, **each one** with gross amount of € **5,000**, included expenses charged to Politecnico di Milano, are intended for **students of** a Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to **Master of Science) Ingegneria Civile** – **Civil** Engineering programmes of Politecnico di Milano.

Scholarships can be renewed for the same amount for the next academic year if requirements of Art. 5 of this Notice are met.

art. 2 Requirements for participation

The competition is open to students of degree courses of Politecnico di Milano that meet the following conditions, by the end of this Notice:



correctly.

- will be enrolled for a.y. 2021/2022 in the first semester in a Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to Master of Science) Ingegneria Civile – Civil Engineering programmes;
- 2. Submission of Study Plan (PSPA) OC2-Idaulica

art. 3 How to participate

Candidates are required to submit the application form through the dedicated function available from On-line services http://www.polimi.it/servizionline (Benefits and agreements> Economic benefits) within 12.00 noon (Italian time) of 09 March 2022.

The completion of the online application is equivalent to submitting an application for participation in this call for applications, and implies acceptance of its contents. It is the applicant's responsibility to check that the procedure has been completed

After having completed and submitted the application, the applicant may print a receipt and the application may no longer be altered. The applicant may delete the application

and submit a new one before the deadline set out in this call for applications.

Failure to complete and submit the application, submitting an incomplete application or submitting inadequate documents will result in the applicant being excluded from the assessment procedure.

art. 4 Granting of scholarship

The assignment of scholarships will be decided on the basis of a first ranking list made by the Research, Innovation and Corporate Relations Division.

The ranking list will be drawn up through the allocation of a score determined by the following formula:

WEIGHTED AVERAGE x REGISTERED CFU (at the deadline of the call)

In case of further equal score, the younger candidate will come first.

All the scholarships of this competition or part of them could not be assigned, in the event that all or part of the candidates will not be considered eligible.

art. 5 Renewal of scholarships



The recipients of "prof. Giorgio Noseda" scholarship for the a.y. 2021/2022 can obtain **the renewal of scholarship** for the next academic year if they meet the conditions below:

- 3. **Be registered in the a.y. 2022/2023** in a Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to Master of Science) Ingegneria Civile Civil Engineering programmes PSPA OC2-Idaulica, within time schedule deadline of academic year
- registration of at **least 35 CFU** regularly registered and useful for graduation within 30 September 2022

The above-mentioned conditions will be verified ex officio by the Research, Innovation and Corporate Relations Division, it allows the automatic renewal of the scholarship to deserving students.

art. 6 General Rules

Combinations: the scholarship cannot be combined with others or other forms of financial aid provided by Politecnico for the same academic year of reference of this call for applications. **The scholarship may be combined with the Diritto allo Studio scholarship and benefits**, and international mobility contributions provided by Politecnico or other public or private entities. The scholarship may also be combined with exemptions from tuition fees and contributions.

Revocation: the scholarship may be revoked if disciplinary sanctions are brought against the beneficiary. It will be revoked if the beneficiary withdraws from their studies or transfers to another university during the year.

Waiver: if the winner waives or fails to return the necessary forms, the prize will be awarded to the next highest applicant in the ranking.

Allocation: the scholarship assignment will be notified to the winner at their official University e-mail address. The winner must return the relevant forms attached to the award notification, signed for acceptance within 10 days of receiving the notice.

The scholarship will be paid in a lump sum by Politecnico di Milano.

If the scholarship is not paid the remaining funds will be used to establish a new call.

Taxation: payments awarded are subject to taxation, under applicable scholarship rules. The scholarship award is treated as employment income, and is subject to the same taxation. The costs borne by Politecnico di Milano correspond to the IRAP rate of 8.5% of the scholarship amount.

PRIVACY POLICY UNDER ARTICLE 13 OF THE EUROPEAN GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION (GDPR)

Politecnico di Milano (henceforth *Politecnico*), in the role of the Data Controller, with offices at Piazza Leonardo da Vinci 32, 20133 Milan – General Management -, informs you about the methods for processing your personal data, in compliance with EU Regulation 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of personal data and its implementation regulations (henceforth the *Regulation*).

The Controller of processing of the data you have provided is the Head of the Research, Innovation and Corporate Relations Division.

A. PERSONAL DATA COLLECTED

The personal data regarding you collected and processed by the Politecnico are (a) the data provided by you upon registration or enrolment, such as name, surname, date and place of birth, sex, tax code, nationality, residential address, telephone and email contact details, educational qualifications; (b) data collected upon submission of your application, in particular, data related to your academic career, the degree programme you have completed, and your financial status data.



B. PROCESSING METHODS AND PURPOSES

Your personal data may be processed for the following purposes:

1. for the public interest of verifying requirements for participation in the procedure according to the criteria set forth in this call for applications and all other legal purposes, including statistical.

In relation to the aforesaid purposes, the data will be processed by Politecnico di Milano using manual, computerised and electronic tools, in a manner pertinent and limited to what is necessary with respect to the purposes for which the data are processed, and in any case in such a way as to guarantee the utmost security and confidentiality and always in full compliance with current legislation.

C.MANDATORY OR VOLUNTARY NATURE OF THE DATA PROVISION

The provision of data for the purposes set forth in section B point 1 is mandatory; any refusal to provide them will result in the inadmissibility of the application and immediate exclusion from the process.

D. SCOPE OF CIRCULATION AND COMMUNICATION OF DATA

Your personal data will be communicated to Politecnico employees who are authorised to process those data, namely natural or legal persons who work with Politecnico to implement the procedures for the selection and assignment of the award under this call. Your data will also be communicated to the donor to inform it of the outcome of the call.

If any contact is made by the donor, **the latter will be understood to be a separate and autonomous controller** of data processing. Therefore, the donor will provide you with an appropriate privacy policy.

E. STORAGE AND POSSIBLE TRANSFER OF PERSONAL DATA

Your personal data will be stored at Politecnico di Milano and will not be transferred to a third country.

F.DATA RETENTION PERIOD

Your personal data will be stored only for as long as strictly necessary in order to meet the requirements of this call for applications, unless it becomes necessary to retain and store the data for a longer period in the public interest. If the data are stored for longer periods, Politecnico guarantees compliance with the data minimisation principle under Art. 89, point 1 of the Regulation.

G. YOUR RIGHTS

You have the right to:

obtain information on the methods by which your data is processed and any other information under Art. 15 of the Regulation (access right)

rectify any of your personal data that are erroneous under Art. 16 of the Regulation (rectification right)

restrict the processing of your personal data under

Art. 18 of the Regulation (right to limit processing);

object to the processing of your personal data in the cases and by the methods under Art. 21 of the Regulation (*right to object*)
