HAVING REGARD to the Decree of the President of the Republic 28 December 2000, n. 445;

HAVING REGARD to Articles 2 and 12 of Ministerial Decree of 9 April 2001, "Equal treatment regarding the right to higher education";

HAVING REGARD to Regulations for Administration, Finance and Accounting, issued by Rectoral decree n. 828 prot.n. 7766 of 14/03/2014 and in particular Articles 75 and 79;

HAVING REGARD to letters protocol n.0177282 del 21/10/2021 by which Francesco Furlani, express the intention to give to Politecnico di Milano the amounts of € 5.000,00 with the aim to promote study activities in engineering field by the allocation of the scholarship named "Antonio Ferraloro", for students of Laurea Magistrale (Msc) in Engineering programmes of Politecnico di Milano;

HAVING REGARDS to Executive Decree 10076/2021 Prot n. 187906 del 03/11/2021 by which is declared the donation acceptance provided by Francesco Furlani;

HEREBY DECREES

The issue of the call for applications **for 2 "Antonio Ferraloro"** scholarships for the 2021/2022 academic year.

art. 1 Description of scholarship and recipients

The n. 2 scholarships, with gross amount of € 2.500.00 each one deductible expenses including charged to Politecnico di Milano, are intended for students enrolled in the Laurea Magistrale (Msc) in Management Engineering - Ingegneria Gestionale programme of Politecnico di Milano.

art. 2 Requirements for participation

The competition is open to students of Politecnico di Milano that meet the following conditions, at the time of the deadline of this call:

1. graduation in the Laurea (equivalent to Bachelor of Science) Engineering programmes of Politecnico di Milano with degree final score of at least 90/110,



- enrolment to the a.y. 2021/2022 in the Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to Master of Science) in Management Engineering - Ingegneria Gestionale programme of Politecnico di Milano
- 3. residence in Italy but not in region Lombardia

art. 3 How to participate

Applicants must submit their request for participation through the specific section in the Online Services http://www.polimi.it/servizionline (Benefits and agreements> Economic benefits) no later than 12.00 pm(midday - Rome time) of 03 December 2021.

The application is complete with the submission of the request for participation in this call for applications and implies the acceptance of its rules and regulations.

Applicants are responsible for checking the procedure is properly completed.

Once the application has been completed and submitted it may no longer be changed and a receipt can be printed. Applicants will be allowed to delete the request and submit it again (ex novo) before the deadline.

Failure to complete and submit the application, submitting an incomplete application or submitting inadequate documents will result in the applicant being excluded from the assessment procedure.

art. 4 Granting of scholarship

The assignment of scholarship will be decided on the basis of the ranking lists made by the Research, Innovation and Corporate Relations Division.

These ranking lists will be drawn up taking into account the **highest BSc degree final score**.

The degree final score 110/110 cum Lode will be counted as 113/110.

With same degree final score, the **candidate with worst economic conditions will come first**.

It will be considered the student's **ISEE certificate (equivalent ISEEU** for those without income in Italy) **2021 valid and compliant** according to the University **database by the end of the call**.

Without an ISEE/ISEEU 2021 certificate valid and compliant, the student will be awarded, for the sole purposes of this ranking list, **the highest** ISEE/ISEEU economic value (€ 95.001).

If the students are still equal, the younger candidate will come first.

The scholarships could not be assigned, in the event that all or part of the candidates will not be considered eligible.

The winners can be invited to a meeting with the donor.

art. 5 General Rules

Cumulability –This scholarship may not be combined with other scholarships or forms of financial assistance awarded by the Politecnico, for the relevant academic year of this Call. The scholarship can however be combined with Diritto allo Studio scholarship and benefits, contributions for international mobility provided by Politecnico or other public or private entity. The scholarship can also be combined with exemptions from university fees and contributions.

Revocation: the scholarship can be revoked if the recipient is subject to disciplinary sanctions. It is still subject to revocation in case of waiver the studies and transfer to another university, current year.

Renunciation: in case the winner renounces or if the forms are not provided within the deadline, the allocation is awarded to the first suitable candidate that follows in the ranking list.

Allocation: the scholarship assignment will be notified to the winner at their official University e-mail address. The winner must return the relevant forms attached to the award notification, signed for acceptance within 10 days of receiving the notice.

The scholarship will be paid in a lump sum by Politecnico di Milano.

If the scholarship is not assigned, the remaining funds will be used to establish a new call for applications.

Tax treatment: assigned contributions are subject to tax purposes and applicable legislation for what concern scholarships. The allocated amount for scholarship can be considered as income from salaried employment and therefore it undergoes the same tax treatment. The expenses charged to Politecnico di Milano corresponds to IRAP rate equal to 8,5% of the amount of the scholarship.

INFORMATION PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 13 OF THE EUROPEAN GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION

Through this document, the Politecnico di Milano (hereinafter also called *Polytechnic*), as Data Controller, with offices located in Piazza Leonardo da Vinci 32, 20133 Milan - General Management -, informs you with regard to the processing of your personal data, in compliance to Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and Council dated 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals regarding the processing of personal data and related implementing legislation (hereinafter also called the *Regulations*).

The Data Processor, of the data provided by you, is the Director of Research, Innovation and Corporate Relations Division.

A. PERSONAL DATA COLLECTED

The personal data collected and processed by the Polytechnic, which regards you, is the following: (a) the data you communicated at the time of registration or enrollment, such as name, surname, date and place of birth, sex, social security number, nationality, address of residence, telephone and IT addresses, qualifications; (b) the data collected at the time of submission of the application, in particular the data relating to your academic career, qualifications achieved, as well as the data to your financial condition.

B. PURPOSE AND METHOD OF PROCESSING

Your personal data may be processed:

1. to verify eligibility requirements to participate in the competition according to the criteria set out in this announcement and for any other purpose required by law, also with the aim of processing statistical information

In relation to the aforementioned purposes, data processing by the Politecnico di Milano will take place using manual, computerized and electronic tools in a relevant manner and limited to what is necessary with respect to the purposes for which they are processed and, in any case, in order to guarantee the maximum security and confidentiality and, always, in full compliance with the legislation in force. The Politecnico will take all measures to promptly correct inaccurate data in relation to the processing purposes.

With reference to the particular data, the processing will be carried out in a proportionate manner with regard to the aim pursued, while adopting appropriate and specific measures to protect your fundamental rights.

C. COMPULSORY AND NON-COMPULSORY DATA

Providing data, for the purposes referred to in paragraph B. point 1, is mandatory and any refusal to provide such data involves the inadmissibility of the application submitted by the student and the immediate exclusion from the procedure

D. DATA CIRCULATION AND COMMUNICATION



Your personal data will be passed on to the Polytechnic employees who will be authorized to process this data, or to natural or legal persons who provide consulting services or collaborate with the Polytechnic for the purpose of providing the selection procedures as foreseen by the competition announcement. Your data will also be communicated to the donor to inform it of the outcome of the call.

If any contact is made by the donor, **the latter will be understood to be a separate and autonomous controller** of data processing. Therefore, the donor will provide you with an appropriate privacy policy.

E. RETENTION AND POSSIBLE TRANSFER OF PERSONAL DATA

Your personal data will be stored at the Politecnico di Milano. Your data will not be transferred to a third country.

F. PERSONAL DATA PERIOD OF RETENTION

Your personal data will be kept for the time strictly necessary to guarantee access to the right to study benefits, unless the retention of data for a longer period is necessary for archiving purposes in the public interest, for scientific or historical research or for statistical purposes. Should data retention be needed for longer periods, the Polytechnic guarantees compliance with the principle of data minimization pursuant to art. 89, paragraph 1 of the Regulations.

G. YOUR RIGHTS

We would like to remind you that you have the right:

- to obtain information in relation to the ways in which your data is processed and any other information required by art. 15 of the Regulations (*right of access*)
- to obtain the correction of inaccurate personal data concerning you pursuant to art. 16 of the Regulations (*rectification right*)
- to obtain a limitation on the processing of personal data concerning you pursuant to art. 18 of the Regulations (*processing restriction right*);
- to oppose the processing of your personal data in the cases and under the conditions provided for by art. 21 of the Regulations (*right of opposition*)
