The call for applications for **Five "Nuove Guglie Carlo Tognoli" degree awards for 2022.**

Art. 1 Introduction

The Centro Studi Grande Milano's "Amare Milano come te" project come from a wish to remember Carlo Tognoli, the unforgettable Mayor of Milan between 1976–1986. Member of Parliament, Euro-parliament member and several times Minister of the Republic, who chose CSGM as the heir to the "Amare Milano" brand, the symbol of those who have the city's destiny at heart.

Tognoli was the first to receive the Centro Studi Grande Milano, "Grandi Guglie" prize, which is awarded to those who have stood out in various fields and enhanced the Milanese metropolitan area's economic, scientific, social, artistic and cultural fabric. Tognoli had a broad vision of Milan - an urban system that embraces a large part of the Lombardy region and in continuous contact with the region's cities.



The idea of naming the "Nuove Guglie" degree award after Carlo Tognoli comes from a wish to give a message of confidence to talented young people who have their eyes set on the future of Milan.

Art. 2 Description of the degree award and recipients

Five degree awards, of € 2,000 gross and net of taxes and fees borne by Politecnico di Milano, will be awarded for the best five degree thesis covering topics connected to:

- Milan and the metropolitan area and its transformations
- Milan and the metropolitan area and the digital transition
- Milan and the metropolitan area and the ecological transition
- Milan and the metropolitan area and social inclusion

Participation is open to students **with a Laurea Magistrale** (equivalent to Master of Science) from Politecnico di Milano:

- Between January and December 2021
- With a graduation score of no less than 100/110

The winners may be offered internships from several leading companies.

The Research, Innovation and Corporate Relations Division will check that the applicants possess the necessary requirements.

Art. 3 Participation procedures

Applicants must submit the application by way of the specific function available from the online Services http://www.polimi.it/servizionline (Agevolazioni e Convenzioni > Borse di studio, premi di laurea, esoneri, bandi generici [Subsidies and Conventions > Scholarships, degree awards, exonerations, generic calls) by 12pm (Italian time) on 25 March 2022.

Applicants must attach:

- 1. **their degree thesis** in PDF format, with a maximum file size of 15 MB
- 2. **a thesis presentation highlighting its main features** and **why it deserves the award** (maximum four A4 pages in Italian or English) in pdf format maximum 5 MB

The file must be named using the following format: Surname-Name-Type of document.pdf (for example, Rossi-Carlo-Thesis.pdf)

Completion of the online application is equivalent to submitting an application for participation in this call for applications, and implies acceptance of its contents. It is the applicant's responsibility to check that the procedure has been completed correctly.



After having completed and submitted the application, the applicant may print a receipt and the application may no longer be modified. The applicant may delete the application and submit a new one before the deadline set out in this call for applications.

Failure to complete and submit the application, submitting an incomplete application or inadequate documents will result in the applicant being excluded from the assessment procedure.

Each co-author for a thesis with multiple participants who intends to compete for the award must present their application for participation individually. In this case, authors must submit the identical documentation required in art. 2.

By submitting the application, the **applicant consents to the material** submitted or part of it being **disseminated** in respect of copyright.

Art. 4 Selection Committee

Granting the degree award uses a ranking drawn up by a Selection Committee appointed by managerial decree following the deadline of the call for applications.

the Committee will decide the ranking based on the attachments using the procedure and their relevance to the themes specified in Art. 1.

Provided that the requirements set out in Art. 1 of the call for applications, if there is a tie, it may divide the award among several applicants.

The Selection Committee may not give the award if none of the applicants are deemed suitable.

The winners are invited to take part in the award ceremony held on 31 May 2022 at Palazzo Marino.

Art. 5 General rules

Award combinations: the degree award cannot be combined with other Politecnico di Milano awards received for the same thesis.

Payment: awarding will be communicated to the winner via their official university email address. Within 10 days of the communication, the winner must return the relevant forms attached to the award notification, signed for acceptance.

The award will be paid in a lump sum by Politecnico di Milano.

Withdrawal: if the winner withdraws or fails to return the necessary forms by the set deadline, the prize will be awarded to the next highest applicant in the ranking.



Taxation: payments awarded are subject to taxation, under applicable scholarship rules. The degree award is treated as employment income, and is subject to the same taxation. The taxes paid by Politecnico di Milano correspond to the IRAP rate of 8.5% of the total degree award.

Art. 6 Head of the Procedure

Under art. 5 of Law, 7 August 1990, no. 241, the Head of this call for applications procedure is Dr Ivano Ciceri.

PRIVACY POLICY UNDER ARTICLE 13 OF THE EUROPEAN GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION (GDPR)



Politecnico di Milano (hereafter *Politecnico*), as Data Controller, with offices at Piazza Leonardo da Vinci 32, 20133 Milan – General Management - informs about personal data processing methods under EU Regulation 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of personal data and its implementation regulations (hereafter the *Regulation*).

The Director of the Research, Innovation and Corporate Relations Division is the Data Processor.

A. PERSONAL DATA COLLECTED

The personal data regarding you collected and processed by the Politecnico is (a) the data provided by you upon registration, such as name, surname, date and place of birth, sex, tax code, nationality, residential address, telephone and email contact details, educational qualifications; (b) the data collected upon submission of your candidature, in particular that related to your academic career, the degree programme you have completed, and the data contained in your dissertation.

B.PROCESSING PURPOSES AND METHODS

Your data may be processed for the following purposes:

1. for the public interest of verifying requirements for participation in the procedure according to the criteria set forth in this call for applications and all other legal purposes, including statistical.

Data will be processed by Politecnico di Milano using manual, computerised and electronic tools, in a manner pertinent and limited to what is necessary for the purposes for which the data is processed, and to guarantee security and confidentiality in compliance with applicable legislation.

C. MANDATORY OR OPTIONAL DATA PROVISION

The provision of data for the purposes set forth in paragraph B point 1 is mandatory, and refusing to provide it will result in inadmissibility of the student's application and immediate exclusion from the process.

D. DATA COMMUNICATION AND CIRCULATION

Your data will be communicated to Politecnico employees who are authorised to process those data, namely natural or legal persons who work with Politecnico to implement the procedures for the selection and assignment of the award under this call

Your data will be communicated to the donor to inform them of the call outcome.

If any contact is made by the donor, they will be considered a separate and independent data controller. The donor will provide you with an appropriate privacy policy.



E. RETENTION AND POSSIBLE TRANSFER OF PERSONAL DATA

Your data will be stored at Politecnico di Milano and will not be transferred to a third-party country.

F. DATA RETENTION PERIOD

Your data will be stored for the time strictly necessary to meet the requirements set forth by this call for applications, unless it is necessary to be stored for a longer period in the public interest. If data is stored for longer, Politecnico guarantees compliance with the data minimisation principle under Art. 89, paragraph 1 of the Regulations.

G. YOUR RIGHTS

You have the right to:

obtain information on the methods by which your data is processed and any other information under Art. 15 of the Regulation (*access right*) rectify any of your data that are erroneous under Art. 16 of the Regulation (*rectification right*)

restrict the processing of your data under

Art. 18 of the Regulation (right to limit processing);

object to the processing of your data in the cases and by the methods under Art. 21 of the Regulation (*right to object*)
