

"Paver Spa" Scholarship for a Civil Engineering Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to a Master of Science) thesis

Academic Year 2024-2025

HAVING REGARD TO letter of intent, ref. no. 0306625 Tit. III Class. 12 of 11/12/2024, in which Nicola Parenti, the legal representative of Paver Costruzioni Spa, located in St. di Cortemaggiore, 25 in Piacenza, expressed the intention to establish a scholarship of €2,000 (two thousand euros), inclusive of costs borne by Politecnico di Milano, for a deserving student enrolled in the Civil Engineering degree programme at Politecnico di Milano. The scholarship is preferably for students residing in the provinces of Piacenza, Lodi, Cremona, Pavia or Parma, who wish to carry out a thesis for a maximum of four months at Paver Costruzioni Spa.

ORDERS

The issuance of the call for applications for a "Paver Spa" scholarship for the Academic Year 2024/2025.

Art.1 - Scholarship description and admission requirements

The scholarship consists of a financial contribution of €2,000 (two thousand euros), gross, which includes costs to be borne by Politecnico di Milano, and requires the recipient to undertake their degree thesis for up to four months at Paver Costruzioni Spa, located in St. di Cortemaggiore, Piacenza.

The "Paver Spa" scholarship is for students who meet the following requirements by the application deadline:

- 1. being regularly enrolled for the academic year 2024/2025 in the Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to a Master of Science) in Civil Engineering at Politecnico di Milano;
- 2. residing in the provinces of Piacenza, Lodi, Cremona, Parma or Pavia;
- 3. being committed to carrying out their thesis for a maximum of four months at Paver Costruzioni Spa, St. di Cortemaggiore, 25 Piacenza.

Art. 2 – Application process

Candidates must apply using the specific form, available from 19/03/2025 and sent no later than 12 noon (Italian time) on 10/04/2025.

Applications can be submitted either in person at the reception of the Piacenza Campus of Politecnico di Milano, Via Scalabrini, 76 or sent by registered mail with return receipt within the prescribed deadline (the postmark will be used as proof of submission date).

Art. 3 - Selection Committee

The scholarship will be awarded following an interview with a Selection Committee composed of Eng. Giuseppe Parenti, Eng. Cesare Montenet and Eng. Leonardo Maffi.

The interview aims to assess the candidates' motivation, skills, and interest in the sector and internship.

The Committee's decision is final.

Art. 4 - General reference rules

Cumulation: the scholarship can be combined with other forms of financial assistance provided by Politecnico di Milano, or with scholarships offered by public or private bodies for the academic year referenced in this call. The scholarship is compatible with tax exemptions, the "Best Freshmen" award and participation in calls for paid student collaborations (200 hours and tutoring).

Revocation: the scholarship may be revoked if the beneficiary is subject to disciplinary sanctions. It will be revoked if the beneficiary withdrawals from their studies or transfers to another university during the academic year.

Withdrawal: If the awarded candidate withdraws or fails to submit the required forms by the specified deadline, the scholarship will be awarded to the next eligible candidate in the ranking.

Award: the scholarship will be awarded following the interview with the Committee and notified to the winner provisionally, at the University's official email address. Within 10 days of receiving this notification, the winner must return the relevant forms signed for acceptance, which will be attached to the award notification.

The scholarship will be disbursed in a single instalment by Politecnico di Milano – Piacenza Campus.

Taxation: scholarship funds are subject to taxation under applicable scholarship regulations. The scholarship amount is treated as employment income for tax purposes. Politecnico di Milano's financial

contribution corresponds to the IRAP (regional tax on productive activities) rate of 8.5% on the scholarship amount.

Self-certification of data: if Politecnico di Milano discovers that false declarations were made, any benefits received will be forfeited.

Art. 5 - Personal data processing

A. PERSONAL DATA COLLECTED

Your personal data will be stored at Politecnico di Milano and will not be transferred to a third country.

F. DATA RETENTION PERIOD

Your personal data will be retained only for as long as strictly necessary in order to meet the requirements of this call for applications, unless it becomes necessary to retain and store the data for a longer period in the public interest. If the data are retained for longer periods, Politecnico guarantees compliance with the data minimisation principle referred to in Article 89.1 of the Regulation.

G. YOUR RIGHTS

You have the following rights: - to obtain information on the methods by which your data are processed and any other information provided for by Article 15 of the Regulation (right of access);- to obtain the rectification of inaccurate personal data, in accordance with Article 16 of the Regulation (right to rectification);- to restrict the processing of your personal data in accordance with Article 18 of the Regulation (right to restriction);- to object to the processing of your personal data in the cases and according to procedures indicated in Article 21 of the Regulation (right of objection).
