DECREES

The issuance of the call for applications for 16 scholarships "Roberto Bertazzoni" a.y. 2022/2023.

art. 1 Scholarship features and recipients

16 scholarships, for a gross amount of € **15,625,00** each and inclusive of charges borne by Politecnico di Milano, are addressed to students who are enrolled in **any Politecnico** di Milano Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to Master of Science) programme.

the scholarships will be distributed proportionally to the number of students enrolled in the Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to Master of Science) programmes, as follows:

no. Two for the School of Design

no. Four for the School of Architecture Urban Planning Construction Engineering

no. Ten for the School of Civil, Environmental and Land Management Engineering and the School of Industrial and Information Engineering

Scholarships will be shared equally between female and male applicants.



art. 2 Admission requirements

Students possessing the following requirements by the call deadline may apply:

- having obtained, in the 2022 calendar year, a Laurea (equivalent to Bachelor of Science) or an international qualification that has been approved for the purposes of enrolling at the Politecnico di Milano
- 2. **enrolment** for the first time in the **a.y. 2022/2023** in one of Politecnico di Milano Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to Master of Science) programmes
- 3. **at least 15 CFU** (including validations) which have been correctly registered on the student's record and are eligible for the purposes of graduation
- 4. weighted average **not less than 28/30** of examinations which have been correctly registered on the student's record and are eligible for the purposes of graduation

Fundraising and Alumni Unit will verify whether the requirements have been met using the Politecnico di Milano's digital archive.

It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that the data present in the Politecnico di Milano's digital archive are correct and current by the deadline of this call for applications.

art. 3 Participation procedures

Applicants must submit the application by way of the specific function available from the online Services http://www.polimi.it/servizionline (Benefits and agreements> Economic benefits) by 12pm (Italian time) on 31 March 2023.

Upon completion of the online application process (status:closed), the application to this call shall be deemed to have been submitted and the applicant shall be understood to have agreed to the contents of the call itself.

It is the applicant's responsibility to check that the process has been completed correctly.

After having completed and submitted the application, the applicant may print a receipt and the application may no longer be altered. The applicant may delete and resubmit the application at any time before the deadline of this call for applications.

Failure to complete the application, the submission of an incomplete application or the submission of inadequate documents shall result in the applicant being excluded from the assessment process.



art. 4 Scholarship assignment

The scholarship will be awarded according to a ranking list compiled by the office of the Fundraising and Alumni Unit based on the information available in the Politecnico di Milano's digital archive.

Six rankings will be generated according to school and gender.

If it is impossible to allocate one or more scholarships within a ranking, the unallocated scholarships will be redistributed among the remaining rankings.

Each ranking will be based upon the score determined by the following formula:

(WEIGHTED AVERAGE x CFU RECORDED) + FINANCIAL STATUS SCORE (at the call deadline)

The financial status score is determined as follows:

2023 ISEE/ISEEU (Equivalent Economic Situation Indicator) VALUE	SCORE
from €0 to €23,120	120
from €23,121 to €27,000	120
from €27,001 to €31,000	80
from €31,001 to €40,000	70
from €40,001 to €51,000	30
from €51,001 to €63,000	20
from €63,001 to €75,000	10
from €75,001 to €95,000	5
from €95,001 to higher amounts	0

A valid and compliant 2023 ISEE (equivalent ISEEU for those not earning income in Italy), found in the University's database by the call deadline will be considered. In the absence of a valid and compliant 2023 ISEE (Equivalent Economic Situation Indicator)/ISEEU the student will be attributed, solely for the purposes of this ranking, the highest ISEE/ISEEU (€95,001).

If the applicants are still equal, priority will be given to the youngest applicant.

The available scholarships may not all be assigned if the applicants are found to be unsuitable.

Winners may be invited to meet with the donor.

art. 5 General rules

Combinations - The scholarship may not be combined with others or other forms of financial aid provided by Politecnico for the same academic year of this call for applications. The scholarship may be combined with the Diritto allo Studio scholarship and benefits, and international mobility contributions provided by Politecnico or other public or private entities. The scholarship may be combined with exemptions from tuition fees and contributions.

Waiver: if the scholarship is waived or the winner fails to deliver the forms, the assignment will be transferred to the next suitable applicant in the ranking in compliance with Article 4.

Allocation: the scholarship assignment will be notified to the winner at their official University e-mail address. Within 10 days of the communication, the winner must return the relevant forms attached to the award notification, signed for acceptance.

The scholarship will be paid in a lump sum by Politecnico di Milano.

If the scholarship is not assigned, the remaining funds will be used to establish a new call for applications.

Revocation: the scholarship may be revoked if disciplinary sanctions are brought against the beneficiary. It will be revoked if the beneficiary withdraws from their studies or transfers to another university during the year.

Self-certification: the Politecnico di Milano will verify the recipient's declarations and any false declarations will result in the forfeiture of any benefits awarded.

Taxation: payments awarded are subject to taxation, under applicable scholarship rules. The scholarship payment is treated as employment income, and is subject to the same taxation. The costs borne by Politecnico di Milano correspond to the IRAP rate of 8.5% of the scholarship amount.

art. 6 Head of the Procedure

Under art. 5 of Italian Law, 7 August 1990, no. 241, the head of the procedure governing this call for applications is Dr. Ivano Ciceri.

PRIVACY POLICY UNDER ARTICLE 13 OF THE EUROPEAN GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION (GDPR)

Politecnico di Milano (hereafter Politecnico), as Data Controller, with offices at Piazza Leonardo da Vinci 32, 20133 Milan – General Management - informs about personal data processing methods under EU Regulation 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of personal data and its implementation regulations (hereafter the Regulation).

The Data Controller for the data you have provided is the Head of the Research, Innovation and Corporate Relations Division.

A.PERSONAL DATA COLLECTED

Your data collected and processed by Politecnico is (a) provided by you upon registration or enrolment, such as name, surname, date and place of birth, gender, tax code, nationality, residential address, telephone and email contact details, educational qualifications; (b) collected upon submission of your application, particularly related to your academic career, ECTS and average.

B.PROCESSING METHODS AND PURPOSES

Your data may be processed for the following purposes:

1) for the public interest of verifying requirements for participation in the procedure according to the criteria set forth in this call for applications and all other legal purposes, including statistical.

Data will be processed by Politecnico di Milano using manual, computerised and electronic tools, in a manner pertinent and limited to what is necessary for the purposes for which the data is processed, and to guarantee security and confidentiality in compliance with applicable legislation.

C.MANDATORY OR VOLUNTARY DATA PROVISION

The provision of data for the purposes set forth in paragraph B point 1 is mandatory, and refusing to provide it will result in inadmissibility of the student's application and immediate exclusion from the process.

D. COMMUNICATION AND CIRCULATION OF DATA

Your personal data will be communicated to Politecnico employees who are authorised to process those data, namely natural or legal persons who work with Politecnico to implement the procedures for the selection and assignment of the award under this call.

Your data will be communicated to the donors to inform them about the call outcome.

If any contact is made by the donor, they will be considered a separate and independent data controller. The donor will provide you with an appropriate privacy policy.



E.RETENTION AND POSSIBLE TRANSFER OF PERSONAL DATA

Your data will be stored at Politecnico di Milano and will not be transferred to a third-party country.

F. DATA RETENTION PERIOD

Your data will be stored for the time strictly necessary to meet the requirements set forth by this call for applications, unless it is necessary to be stored for a longer period in the public interest. If data is stored for longer, Politecnico guarantees compliance with the data minimisation principle under Art. 89, point 1 of the Regulation.

G. YOUR RIGHTS

You have the following rights:

- obtain information on the methods by which your data is processed and any other information under Art. 15 of the Regulation (access right)
- -rectify any of your personal data that are erroneous under Art. 16 of the Regulation (rectification right)
- restrict the processing of your data under

Art. 18 of the Regulation (right to limit processing);

- object to the processing of your data in the cases and by the methods under Art. 21 of the Regulation (right to object)
