DECREES

The call for applications for **Two "Mauro Meroni" degree awards year 2023.**

Art.1 Premise

Mauro Meroni, alumnus of the Politecnico di Milano in Aeronautical Engineering, was a young manager in the ICT field. He was also a great mountain enthusiast: CAI instructor at the Como ski mountaineering school and retired Alpini Corps officer at the Alpine Military School of Aosta.

Family, friends and colleagues want to remember him with the graduation award named after him..

Art. 2 Description of the degree award and recipients

The two degree awards, of **€ 1,750** gross and inclusive of taxes and fees borne by Politecnico di Milano, will be awarded for the best degree thesis covering **topics connected to:**

- Development of innovative solutions for mountain sports
- Enhancement, sustainability, attractiveness and safety of high-altitude settlements and mountain regions

Students who **have obtained a Laurea Magistrale** (equivalent to Master of Science) or a Laurea A Ciclo Unico (equivalent to Integrated Master of Science **qualification** from Politecnico di Milano Schools are eligible to participate:

- Between **January and December 2022**
- With **marks of no less than 108/110**

The Fundraising and Alumni Unit will verify whether the requirements have been met, using the Politecnico di Milano's digital archive.

It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that the data present in the Politecnico di Milano's digital archive are correct and current by the deadline of this call for applications.

Art. 3 **Participation procedures**

Applicants must submit their application through the appropriate function available in the Online Services: <http://www.polimi.it/servizionline> ((Benefits and agreements> Economic benefits) **by 12 pm (Italian time) on 31 March 2023.**

Applicants **must attach:**

- their degree thesis in PDF format, with a maximum file size of 15MB
- a thesis presentation highlighting its main features and why it deserves the award (maximum four A4 pages in Italian or English) in pdf format maximum 5 MB

The file must be named using the following format: Surname-Name-Type of document.pdf (for example, Rossi-Carlo-Thesis.pdf)

Upon completion of the online application process (status:closed), the application to this call shall be deemed to have been submitted and the applicant shall be understood to have agreed to the contents of the call itself.

It is the applicant's responsibility to check that the process has been completed correctly.

After having completed and submitted the application, the applicant may print a receipt and the application may no longer be altered. The applicant may delete the application and submit a new one at any time before the deadline set out in this call.

Failure to complete the application, the submission of an incomplete application or the submission of inadequate documents shall result in the applicant being excluded from the assessment process.

In the case of theses with multiple authors, each co-author that intends to apply for the award must submit an individual application.

In this case, all authors must submit identical documentation, as requested in Art.3.

Should one or more of the co-authors not wish to participate, it shall be left to the applicant author to decide whether to contact them in the event of winning the prize.

Art. 4
Selection Committee

Granting the degree award uses a ranking drawn up by a Selection Committee appointed by managerial decree following the deadline of the call for applications.

The Committee will decide the ranking based on the attachments using the procedure and their relevance to the themes specified in Art. 2.

Provided that the requirements set out in Art. 2 of the call for applications, if there is a tie, it may divide the prize among several applicants.

The Selection Committee may not award the prize if none of the applicants are deemed suitable.

The winner may be invited to a meeting with the donor family.

Art. 5
General rules

Award combinations: the degree award cannot be combined with other awards received by Politecnico di Milano for the same thesis.

Payment: awarding will be communicated to the winner via their official university email address. Within 10 days of receiving that communication, the winner must return the relevant forms attached to the award notification, signed for acceptance.

The award will be paid in a lump sum by Politecnico di Milano.

Withdrawal: if the winner withdraws or fails to return the necessary forms by the set deadline, the prize will be awarded to the next highest applicant in the ranking.

Taxation: payments awarded are subject to taxation, under applicable scholarship rules. The degree award is treated as employment income, and is subject to the same taxation. The taxes paid by Politecnico di Milano correspond to the IRAP rate of 8.5% of the total degree award.

**PRIVACY POLICY UNDER ARTICLE 13 OF THE EUROPEAN
GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION (GDPR)**

Politecnico di Milano (henceforth **Politecnico**), in the role of the Data Controller, with offices at Piazza Leonardo da Vinci 32, 20133 Milan – General Management -, informs you about the methods for processing your personal data, in compliance with EU Regulation 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of personal data and its implementation regulations (henceforth the **Regulation**).

The Director of the Research, Innovation and Corporate Relations Division is the Data Processor.

A. PERSONAL DATA COLLECTED

The personal data regarding you collected and processed by the Politecnico is **(a)** the data provided by you upon registration, such as name, surname, date and place of birth, sex, tax code, nationality, residential address, telephone and email contact details, educational qualifications; **(b)** the data collected upon submission of your candidature, in particular that related to your academic career, the degree programme you have completed, and the data contained in your dissertation.

B. PROCESSING PURPOSES AND METHODS

Your personal data may be processed for the following purposes:

1. for the public interest of verifying requirements for participation in the procedure according to the criteria set forth in this call for applications and all other legal purposes, including statistical.

Data will be processed by Politecnico di Milano using manual, computerised and electronic tools, in a manner pertinent and limited to what is necessary for the purposes for which the data is processed, and to guarantee security and confidentiality in full compliance with applicable legislation.

C. MANDATORY OR OPTIONAL DATA PROVISION

The provision of data for the purposes set forth in paragraph B point 1 is mandatory, and refusing to provide it will result in inadmissibility of the student's application and immediate exclusion from the process.

D. DATA COMMUNICATION AND CIRCULATION

Your personal data will be communicated to Politecnico employees who are authorised to process those data, namely natural or legal persons who work with Politecnico to implement the procedures for the selection and assignment of the award under this call.

Your data will be communicated to the donor to inform them of the call outcome.

E. RETENTION AND POSSIBLE TRANSFER OF PERSONAL DATA

If the data are stored for longer periods, Politecnico guarantees compliance with the data minimisation principle under Art. 89, paragraph 1 of the Regulations.

G. YOUR RIGHTS

You have the right to:

rectify any of your personal data that are erroneous under Art. 16 of the Regulation (*rectification right*)

restrict the processing of your personal data under Art. 18 of the Regulation (*right to limit processing*);

object to the processing of your personal data in the cases and by the methods under Art. 21 of the Regulation (*right to object*)
