HAVING REGARD TO Italian Presidential Decree No. 445 of 28 December 2000;

HAVING REGARD TO Articles 2 and 12 of Italian Prime Ministerial Decree of 9 April 2001, “Equal treatment in the right to higher education”;

HAVING REGARD TO the Regulation for Administration, Finance and Accounting, issued by Rectoral Decree No. 828 Ref. No. 7766 of 14/03/2014 and in particular Articles 75 and 79;

HAVING REGARD TO letter Ref. No. 178902 of 25/07/2022 with which Sandra de Benedetti Böhm, in her capacity as Honorary President of Compagnia Generale Trattori S.p.A., expressed the desire to donate, free of charge, a total sum of €6,510.00 to the Politecnico di Milano in order to support the implementation of No. 2 degree prizes in memory of the engineer Sergio Böhm for graduates of Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to Master of Science) programmes at the Politecnico di Milano;

HAVING REGARD TO Managerial Decree 7813/2022 Ref. No. 182094 of 28/07/2022 with which the donation offered by Sandra De Benedetti Böhm, Honorary President of Compagnia Generale Trattori S.p.A. was accepted;

HEREBY DECREES

The enactment of the call for applications for **No. 2 “Sergio Böhm” degree prizes for the year 2022.**

Art.1

Introduction

2022 marks the thirtieth anniversary of the disappearance of the engineer Sergio Böhm who was the President of Compagnia Generale Trattori S.p.A. (an Italian CATERPILLAR dealer) for many years.

His studies in Mechanical Engineering at the Politecnico di Torino and his strong managerial culture pushed the company towards innovation, transforming it into a modern and highly regarded business both nationally and internationally. The engineer Sergio Böhm, the Managing Director of Compagnia Generale Trattori S.p.A. from 1963 onwards, was one of the first in Italy to incorporate personal computers into the management of the business in the early 1980s.

In his memory, the prize bearing his name has been created.

Art. 2

Description of the degree prize and recipients

The degree prizes will be divided as follows:

A degree prize, with a value of **€3,000.00** gross and net of the charges to be paid by the Politecnico di Milano, will be awarded **to the best degree thesis** that addresses **topics relating to:**

- *Energy Transition: the role of hydrogen in the energy transition in industrial applications.*

The call is open to students who have **graduated with a Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to Master of Science)** from the Politecnico di Milano in:

- Energy Engineering- Ingegneria Energetica
- Mechanical Engineering- Ingegneria Meccanica
- Mathematical Engineering- Ingegneria Matematica
- Aeronautical Engineering -Ingegneria Aeronautica
- During the period from **January 2021 to December 2022**
- With a **degree score no lower than 105/110**

A degree prize, with a value of **€3,000.00** gross and net of the charges to be paid by the Politecnico di Milano, will be awarded **to the best degree thesis** that addresses **topics relating to:**

- *Telemetry. How to use the operating data of industrial machinery and the alerts that are transmitted in order to produce innovative predictive services.*

The call is open to students who have **graduated with a Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to Master of Science)** from the Politecnico di Milano in:

- Mechanical Engineering- Ingegneria Meccanica
- Electronics Engineering- Ingegneria Elettronica
- Engineering Physics-Ingegneria Fisica
- During the period from **January 2021 to December 2022**
- With a **degree score no lower than 105/110**

The Fundraising and Alumni Unit will verify whether the requirements have been met using the Politecnico di Milano's digital archive.

Art. 3 **Application procedure**

Applicants must submit an application using the relevant function available within Online Services

<http://www.polimi.it/servizionline> (Agevolazioni e Convenzioni > Borse di studio, premi di laurea, esoneri, bandi generici) **by 12.00 (Italian time) on 31 January 2023.**

Applicants **must attach**, through the appropriate procedure:

- 1. the degree thesis** in a PDF file **no larger than 20 MB**
- 2. a presentation of the thesis highlighting the distinguishing features** of the paper and **the reasons for which it is deserving of the prize** (no more than four A4 pages in Italian or English) in a PDF file no larger than 5 MB

The files must be named using the format Surname-Name-Type of document.pdf (for example Smith-John-Thesis.pdf).

Upon completion of the online application process (status:closed), the application to this call shall be deemed to have been submitted and the applicant shall be understood to have agreed to the contents of the call itself.

It is the applicant's responsibility to check that the process has been completed correctly.

After having completed and submitted the application, the applicant may print a receipt and the application may no longer be altered. The applicant may delete and resubmit the application at any time before the deadline of this call for applications.

Failure to complete the application, the submission of an incomplete application or the submission of inadequate documents shall result in the applicant being excluded from the assessment process.

In the case of theses with multiple authors, each co-author that intends to apply for the award must submit an individual application.

In this case, all authors must submit identical documentation, as requested in Art. 2.

By submitting an application, **the applicant agrees that the material submitted**, or part of the same, may be **disseminated** in accordance with copyright.

Art. 4 **Selection Board**

The award of the degree prize shall be decided on the basis of a ranking list drawn up by a Selection Board appointed by managerial decree after the deadline of this call for applications.

In formulating the ranking, the board shall make a decision on the basis of the attachments uploaded through the appropriate procedure and their relevance and significance to the topic indicated in Art. 2.

Provided that the requirements set out in Art. 2 of the call for applications have been met, the board may award the prize to more than one candidate in the event of a tie. The Selection Board may choose not to award the prize in the event that the none of the applicants is deemed eligible.

The winners will be invited to take part in a prize ceremony at the company's registered office in Vimodrone (Milan).

Art. 5 **General rules**

Accumulation: this degree award cannot be combined with other Politecnico di Milano awards received for the same thesis.

Payment: the winners of the degree prize will be notified through their university e-mail address. Within 10 days of receiving said notification, the winner must sign and return the relevant forms attached to the award notification.

The prize shall be disbursed by the Politecnico di Milano in a single payment.

Withdrawal: should the winner withdraw from the call or fail to return the forms within the deadline, the prize shall be awarded to the next applicant in the ranking.

Taxation: the degree prize will be subject to taxation, in accordance with current legislation relating to scholarships. The amount paid by way of degree prize shall be treated as employment income for tax purposes and shall therefore be subject to the same taxation. The costs borne by the Politecnico di Milano correspond to the rate of regional tax on productive activity, amounting to 8.5% of the degree prize amount.

Art. 6 **Party responsible for the procedure**

In accordance with the provisions of Art. 5 of Italian Law No. 241 of 7 August 1990, the party responsible for this call procedure is Mr Ivano Ciceri.

The Politecnico di Milano (hereinafter also **Politecnico**), in its capacity as Data Controller, with registered address in Piazza Leonardo da Vinci 32, 20133 Milan - General Management -, hereby informs you of the methods for processing your personal data, in compliance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 relating to the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and the corresponding implementing acts (hereinafter also the **Regulation**).

The Data Processor of the data you have provided is the Director of Research, Innovation and Corporate Relations.

A. PERSONAL DATA COLLECTED

The personal data concerning you collected and processed by the Politecnico are **(a)** the data provided by you at the time of registration or enrolment, including name, surname, date and place of birth, gender, tax code, nationality, home address, telephone and email contact details, academic qualifications; **(b)** the data collected when completing your application, in particular those relating to your academic career and the qualifications you have obtained, as well as the information contained in your thesis.

B. PROCESSING PURPOSES AND METHODS

Your personal data may be processed for the following purposes:

1. for the public interest of verifying the requirements for participation in the competition according to the criteria stated in this call for applications and all purposes provided for by law, including for statistical purposes.

In relation to the aforementioned purposes, the data processing shall be carried out by the Politecnico di Milano using manual, computerised and electronic tools, in a manner that is relevant and limited to what is necessary in relation to the purposes for which they are processed and, in any case, in such a way as to guarantee the utmost security and confidentiality and always in full compliance with the legislation in force.

C. MANDATORY OR VOLUNTARY NATURE OF DATA PROVISION

The provision of data for the purposes indicated in section B 1. is mandatory and any refusal to provide such data will result in the inadmissibility of the application submitted by the student and his/her immediate exclusion from the procedure.

D. SCOPE OF MOVEMENT AND DISCLOSURE OF THE DATA

Your personal data will be disclosed to Politecnico employees who are authorised to process such data, namely natural or legal persons who work with the Politecnico for the purposes of implementing the procedures for the selection and awarding of the scholarship provided for by this call.

Your data will also be disclosed to the donor to inform them of the results of the call.

In the event of any contact made by the donor, they shall be understood to be a distinct and autonomous data controller of your personal data. As such, the donor shall provide you with the corresponding privacy policy.

E. STORAGE AND POSSIBLE TRANSFER OF PERSONAL DATA

Your personal data will be stored at the Politecnico di Milano and will not be transferred to a third country.

F. DATA RETENTION PERIOD

Your personal data shall be retained only for as long as strictly necessary in order to meet the requirements of this call for applications unless it becomes necessary to retain and store the data for a longer period for archiving purposes in the public interest. If the data are stored for longer periods, the Politecnico guarantees compliance with the data minimisation principle under Art. 89, par. 1 of the Regulation.

G. YOUR RIGHTS

Please note that you have the right:

to obtain the rectification of inaccurate personal data concerning you pursuant to Art. 16 of the Regulation (*'right to rectification'*);
to obtain a restriction of the processing of personal data concerning you, pursuant to Art. 18 of the Regulation (*'right to restriction of processing'*);
to object to the processing of your personal data in the cases and by the methods set forth in Art. 21 of the Regulation (*'right to object'*).
